If you're considering a high deductible health plan and are currently enrolled in the Diabetes Care Rewards Program, make sure to check your health plan's Preventive Drug List.

WHAT IS A PREVENTIVE DRUG LIST

A Preventive Drug List is a list of medications and supplies that help prevent chronic conditions and illnesses like diabetes. You can get the drugs on the list for a copay BEFORE having to meet your health plan deductible. **Having a Preventive Drug List means your cost is lower for the drugs on the list since you'll pay a copay instead of the full price.**

Blue Cross Blue Shield of Massachusetts and Harvard Pilgrim Health Care offer a Preventive Drug List that includes most commonly used diabetes medications and supplies. To see if your medication is listed, go online to ccmhg.com, click on Employees & Retirees, then select HSA Qualified Plans. If your medication or supply is not listed, **contact your health plan** to see if it is available on their Preventive Drug List. Medications not on your health plan's list will be subject to the deductible.

HOW DOES ELECTING A HIGH DEDUCTIBLE HEALTH PLAN AFFECT GETTING \$0 COPAYS IN THE DIABETES CARE REWARDS PROGRAM

As long as you are meeting all of the program requirements, and your medications and/or supplies are on your health plan's Preventive Drug List, you can continue to obtain covered diabetes medications and supplies for \$0 copays through the program.
